



Employment rates from courses for which there is no follow-on degree programme, e.g., hairdressing and beauty therapy, are consistently high, up to 100% for some courses. Many students have job offers before they have even completed their course.



# Start your Degree Programme at Cavan Institute

The first year of the following degree programmes are also offered at Cavan Institute. Students apply directly to Cavan Institute for places on these courses and points apply for entry to these courses.



**Bachelor of Arts in Applied Social Studies in Social Care.** This is a 3-year, level 7 degree programme, with year 1 delivered at Cavan Institute and years 2 and 3 at AIT. Students register with AIT and points apply.

**Higher Certificate in Business.** This is a 2-year, level 6 course, with year 1 delivered at Cavan Institute and year 2 at AIT. As before, students register with AIT and points apply.



**Bachelor of Science in Computing.** This is a 3-year, level 7 degree programme, with year 1 delivered at Cavan Institute and the remaining years delivered at LYIT. Students register with LYIT and points apply.

There are **no points requirements** for entry to any PLC course.



# **Career Guidance** Service

At Cavan Institute, we offer a comprehensive Career Guidance Service available to all students throughout the academic year. The service is student-focused, professional and informative and it assists students with all aspects of career planning and the transition from further education to higher education and/or to the world of work. Our staff will help you to make informed decisions about your career choices through a variety of career workshops, career talks and guest speakers from industry and higher education institutes. They also help students to develop their jobsearch skills, to write a CV and to develop their interview techniques in preparation for the working world.

### Fees

There is a vast difference between fees charged by Cavan Institute and those of higher education colleges.

Cavan Institute's annual registration fee is €300, plus a €200 government levy. Please note that this government levy is refundable to medical card holders, grant recipients and students in receipt of BTEA or VTOS support.

The fees for each course differ depending on the nature of the course and the materials required. Please refer to the Institute's website for all course fees and course requirements.

# Sources of Financial Support

#### 1. PLC Maintenance Grant

Means-tested maintenance grants are available to eligible students attending approved full-time courses of further education in approved Post Leaving Certificate (PLC) centres, of which Cavan Institute is one. Applications can be made online to Student Universal Support Ireland (SUSI) through www.studentfinance.ie or www.susi.ie

#### 2. Back to Education Allowance (BTEA)

The Back to Education Allowance (BTEA) allows people in receipt of certain social welfare payments to retain those payments whilst participating in approved full-time courses in further education. See **www.welfare.ie** or **www.studentfinance.ie** for further details.

#### 3. Vocational Training Opportunities Scheme (VTOS)

This scheme allows unemployed people aged over 21 to engage in education and training without losing their benefits. It applies to all courses offered at Cavan Institute and applicants must be in receipt of one of a number of social welfare supports for at least six months. See www.vtos.ie for further details.

#### 4. HEA Fund for Students with Disabilities

The Higher Education Authority's "Fund for Students with Disabilities" allocates funding to further and higher education colleges for the provision of services and supports to full-time students with disabilities. Applications to the

#### **Course Description:**

This course is aimed at anyone who is interested in pursuing a career in accounting/finance. Accounting technicians are skilled individuals who work at middle management level and who provide essential financial and accounting support information to professional accountants and to senior

management. Some examples of positions available to qualified accounting technicians include: accounting supervisor, budget officer, assistant accountant and payroll administrator.

At the end of their two years of study and having complied with all the requirements of Accounting Technicians Ireland, students will be awarded the Certificate MATI (Member of the Accounting Technicians Ireland).

### Career/Progression Opportunities:

The accounting technician qualification is a recognised pathway to attaining a professional accountancy qualification through the Certified Public Accountancy course available at Cavan Institute and elsewhere. Even if you do not aspire to qualifying as a professional accountant, the course provides you with a solid theoretical and practical knowledge base that can be used to achieve a successful career in other related areas of business.

This course is designed to help students develop the essential accounting and financial knowledge and skills which form the basis for a career in industry, commerce or the public service. The course comprises both theoretical and practical modules, and students will gain an understanding of both manual and integrated accounting software. There is a focus in this course on the functional areas of accounting, finance and business and the factors which influence business success.

#### **Entry Requirements:**

Leaving Certificate or Leaving Certificate Applied or LCVP or QQI Level 4 Award. Equal consideration will be given to mature applicants (those aged over 23) who do not meet these entry requirements.

#### **Course Description:**

This course is suitable for individuals who have an interest in holistic therapies and would like to pursue a career in this area or add to existing qualifications. It is aimed at giving a comprehensive understanding in a wide variety of the most popular therapies leading to internationally recognised qualifications. Students get hand-on experience and real world experience through providing supervised

treatments in the clinic on campus. There is a focus on this course on practicing treatments and developing existing skills to industry standard. Work experience in complementary therapy is an integral part of the course. In order to complete the course successfully, students must meet all the necessary criteria as stipulated by the international examination bodies, including completion of required course hours and project work.

#### **Career Opportunities:**

Students who successfully complete this course may obtain positions as complementary therapists in beauty salons, hotel spas, health centres, healing centres, or they may become sales representatives

and trainers for health products. Graduates of this course have the necessary qualifications to start their own business. The Internationally recognised diplomas that Cavan Institute offer, provide a career passport for the more adventurous students who wish to see the world, excellent job opportunities are also available on cruise liners.

#### **Course Description:**

This course is designed for those who wish to qualify as a professional make-up artist. It covers all aspect of makeup artistry, including fashion, theatre, TV, film and special effects make-up. It combines the technical skills and artistic elements required of a make-up artist with a focus on fashion co-ordination, hair styles and special effects. This course covers the skills required to perform effective make-up techniques suitable for various professional media, theatre and stage productions. As part of this course, students create make-up looks for fashion

shows, magazine shoots and theatrical performances and in the process develop a comprehensive portfolio featuring a range of different looks.

#### **Career Opportunities:**

Employment opportunities exist in a variety of industries, including theatre, film and television and on a range of media productions, including editorials and high fashion (catwalk). Graduates of this course can expect to find employment with international cosmetic companies, as cosmetic consultants/make-up artists and cosmetic counter managers.

This course is designed for students who are interested in the area of nail extensions. It will provide students with the skills, knowledge and qualifications required to work as a nail technician. Further, it will also equip students to efficiently carry out tanning and nail art treatments. Students will study and practice manicure treatments, pedicure treatments, nail extension systems (gel, acrylic, fiberglass, overlays), nail art, anatomy and physiology and product knowledge/ cosmetic science. There is a strong

emphasis on theory as well as practical work and a high level of commitment is required. Students complete case studies on guest clients for each module, performing facial, waxing, manicure, pedicure and make up treatments. They also carry out work experience in a beauty salon/health spa of their choice, where they get a true insight into the professional beauty industry.

#### **Career Opportunities:**

Students will complete case studies on guest clients for each module, performing treatments such as body massage and figure analysis, epilation, microdermabrasion and IPL, and learning correct use of electrical machines. As part of this course, students actively design, set up and

participate in the Institute's commercial salon, which runs on a weekly basis. This experience empowers the students, building their confidence to make the transition to professional beauty therapist. Additional workshops may be offered in gel nails, specialised waxing, hot stones and hopi ear candling.

#### **Course Description:**

This course is designed to give students a firm foundation in the skills necessary for a career in interior architecture. Students will gain design, representation and analytical skills in a studiobased environment. There is a strong emphasis on problem solving, including the ability to think creatively, threedimensionally and technically. Students will gain exposure to skills relating to the construction, refurbishment, retrofit and fit-out of both new and existing buildings. Design communication skills will enable students to draw and communicate using conventional hand-drawing techniques, 2D AutoCAD and 2D/3D Parametric CAD.

#### **Career Opportunities:**

Graduates of this course will have the skills necessary to pursue a career in architecture, interior design and interior architecture. The course may also appeal to those interested in working on a self-employed basis, working in retail display or working in design industries.

#### **Course Description:**

This course is designed to give students a firm foundation in Computer Aided Design (CAD). CAD technology is used to create graphics and make calculations needed in the production of drawings, three-dimensional simulations, models and other design work. 

Further study may lead graduates to a career in facilities management or into management and administrative roles within services such as the national ambulance service, the fire service, local government and the prison service.

#### **Career Opportunities:**

Graduates of this course will gain the necessary skills and knowledge to be eligible to apply for work in a specialised custodial or healthcare setting but they will also have necessary core skills to work as a security officer in any traditional settings.




